Title / Issue / Request:

G.O. Bond Project(s) Review

Background / Justification:

During a series of work session meetings over the past several months, the City Council has determined that it is necessary to borrow (a) \$6,750,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, renovating, and equipping improvements to the park system within the City and (b) \$3,300,000 for the purpose of acquiring rights of way, constructing, extending, and improving streets and roads within the City.

An ordinance calling for this election on Tuesday, April 5, 2016 on these proposed bond issuances has been prepared and authorized by the Council.



The proposed specific projects to be funded on the “Parks” question include:

- Parks and Recreation Activity Building to Replace Park House at Recreation Park \$2,843,000
- Recreation Trail Rehabilitation \$55,000
- Recreation Park Parking Lot Rehabilitation \$54,000
- Hawk Ridge Parking Expansion and ADA Playground System \$700,000
- Hawk Ridge Park Amphitheater and Amenities \$675,100
- T.B. Hanna Station Water Park/Ice Skating Rink/Playground \$600,000
- Additional Signage - Hawk Ridge Park \$85,000
- Municipal Circle Meeting Space Expansion Project \$1,500,000
