- A.** Evan Brook 7th Plat - Discussion of Impact
The agenda for the October 24 meeting of the City Council included items for approval of the Preliminary and Final Plat for the Evan Brook 7th and final phase. At that meeting, the Council postponed consideration of these items until the November 14 Council meeting and asked that the Evan Brook 7th plat be brought to this November 7 Council Work Session for discussion about the impacts of the plat on surrounding areas, specifically Dutchman Acres. The item is now placed on the agenda accordingly.
- B.** Chaplains Program
This item on the agenda allows for the Police Department Chaplains to annually meet with the City Council to discuss their program and what has happened over the last year. It gives the Council the opportunity to ask questions about the program and to hear what plans are in place for the next fiscal year as well.

At that meeting the Council also gave input on a number of other names for consideration and asked that the final consideration of a name be put onto this agenda.


The Raymore City Council is scheduled to go into executive session to discuss Litigation matters as authorized by RSMo 610.021 (1)





Sunset Lane Road Taper Plan





RE: Municipal Center Name Recommendation - Centerview

The project team for the Municipal Center project would like to propose the name Centerview for the building.

According to the Raymore Centennial Book, Centerview was one of the original Raymore Township country schools and was located across from the Gore farm. Other country schools included Funk, Greenlee, Harrelson (originally called Selden Seen), and Gilmore. The country schools merged into the Raymore Consolidated School after a vote in 1916.



Centerview was selected as the recommendation because in addition to referencing a part of the City's history, the name also ties nicely with the location of the building. With the addition of this building and the connecting trail network, Municipal Circle is positioned to become the city "center."

Staff also recommends utilizing the names of additional country schools for the meeting spaces inside the building. The large event space could be Harrelson Hall and the the small meeting room could be either the Greenlee Room or the Gilmore Room. A historical sign or display could also be included in the building to provide information about the schools and where the names originated.
